## 2 Thessalonians 1

### Answer, Discuss, & Apply

What are some memories you have of receiving something special in the mail?

**Read 2 Thessalonians 1:1-2.** These verses align with the common tradition in letters of antiquity to give a greeting. Paul makes it distinctly Christian in nature.

What are some of the words or phrases that you would highlight that make this greeting uniquely Christian?

Josh talked about how these verses acknowledge God first in a thank you letter written to the Thessalonians. How can you say, **“Thank you God!”** first this week in your life?

**Read 2 Thessalonians 1:3-10.** Paul mentions the persecution and trials that the Thessalonians have endured and their perseverance of faith throughout all circumstances. Also, he talks about how they will persevere until Jesus’ return.

How does Paul say Christians should view Jesus’ return?

Josh preached on how we can say to God, **“Thank you for everything!”**. How does this section of verses highlight that truth? What can you say thank you to God for today?

**Read 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12.** The final point of Sunday’s sermon was **“Thank you for fruit!”**. What do you need God’s help for in order to live out His calling for your life? Make sure to thank Him for how He will work now and in the future in order to bring this into fruition.
