Answer, Discuss, & Apply

Why is the gospel a gospel of grace rather than a gospel by works of law?
Read and memorize Romans 3:23 and Romans 3:28.

Read Romans 4:1-5. According to verse 5, who does God justify? Knowing this truth, what attitude should you have? Do you display this attitude on a consistent basis? If not, how can you more often?

Have you ever had a wages mentality in regard to what God gives? If so, how can you continue to realize what God gives is because of grace? How can you show grace just as you've received grace?

Read Romans 4:6-8. According to David, does God credit someone righteous by works or apart from works?

Read Romans 4:9-12. Like Jews during Paul's time, have you ever felt you have a right to being part of the family of God simply because of your physical heritage? What could change a person's mindset, knowing that it is by faith in God's grace that anyone is part of God's spiritual family?

Read Romans 4:13-17a. How is the Abrahamic promise received?

Read Romans 4:17b-22. Following the example of Abraham, how can you give God glory and believe His promises? Do you believe God is able? Spend some time reflecting on the nature and work of God.

Read Romans 4:23-25. Have you surrendered your life to God through faith? Is there someone you know that you need to share the gospel with? Commit to sharing the gospel with that person this week.
